

Authors' Template - INSTRUCTION

The editors of the WFPnC-Journal ask you to do the following:

- You are asked to write your article in a Windows Word format.
- For formatting your article use the given "Authors'-Template-Form", please.
- The given font-type is "Arial".
- All types of text, like headlines, sub-headlines, running text, and so on are formatted in this "Authors'-Template-Form", including the distance between the lines and the letters and the page-numbers.
One can use this template directly or by copy and paste.
- Using Office-2007 or some newer version you can find the given formatting in the top line.
- Put in figures where you want to place them.
- Write the caption as an extra-text, not in connection with the figure, please.
- To be on the safe side, send all the figures as extra files, as large as it can be (in terms of MB). Label them with a name and a number, please.
(e.g.: Smith-08)
- Don't draw figures by using Word-drawing-programmes, please !
Use only figures with such a format that it can be made larger or smaller.
- To put in formulas use the formula editor of Word, please.
